

Fall 2021 Demographics Report

Summary

Every year The Department of Institutional Research (IR) creates a fall demographics report following the conclusion of the fall term. The purpose of the report is to provide annual information on student enrolment at the college.

Some notes about the report

- For the purpose of yearly comparison, the same methodology is used each year.
- This report does not include Continuing Studies students due to differences in methodology and definitions.
- A version of this report is posted on the public IR webpage in a masked format. In that version, each number or total greater than 0 but less than five has been masked with an *. This masking is required for privacy as per the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training (AEST) guidelines.
- All values of 0 are represented by blank cells.
- Full-time refers to a course load of 80 per cent or more, rounded up where applicable.
- Campus refers to a student's home campus that is assigned to them at the time of admission.
- Only students who have registrations in the fall term are included. Students who are block registered in a program that overlaps the fall term are excluded.
- Throughout this report, "Intl Total" refers to the sum of International and Exchange to OC students.
- Standard deviation is a statistic used throughout this report to describe the amount of variance in student ages within a data set. A higher standard deviation (St. Dev) indicates that the student ages are more widely spread out from the average of the data set. A lower standard deviation indicates that the ages are clustered closer to the average.
- Totals will vary slightly based on categorical breakdowns.

Demographic Statistics at a Glance:

- Fall 2021 headcount is 6,960, down slightly from 6,991 last fall (fall 2020).
- 68% of students come from the Okanagan region, compared to 68% last fall and 83% in fall 2011.
- 16% of students are international, compared to 19% last fall and 7% in fall 2011.
- 29% of students (2,006) were new to Okanagan College, up from 23% last fall.
- 54% of students study full-time, compared to 55% last fall.
- 64% of students attend the Kelowna campus, down 3% from last fall.
- 55% of students are female, up 1% from last fall.
- Average student age is 26, consistent with last fall.
- 59% of Okanagan College students are less than 25 years of age, down from 62% last fall.
- 23% of all students are under 20, consistent with last fall.
- The Penticton campus has the oldest students with an average age of 27, where last fall Salmon Arm and Penticton campuses had the oldest students with an average age of 26.
- There were no exchange students from Okanagan College studying abroad in fall 2021.
- There were three exchange students from abroad studying at Okanagan College in fall 2021.

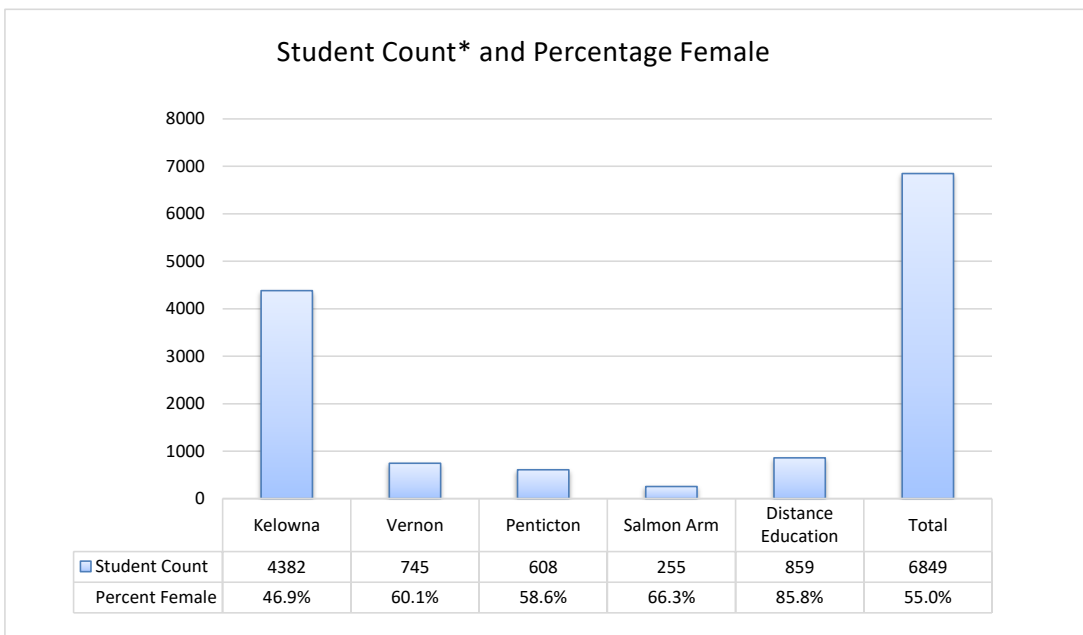
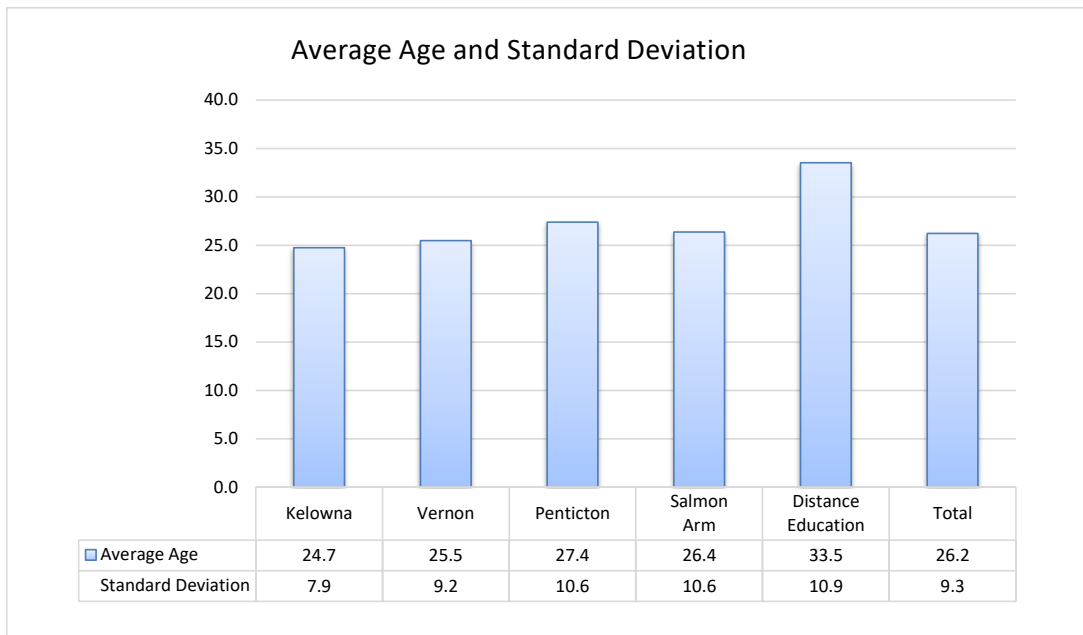

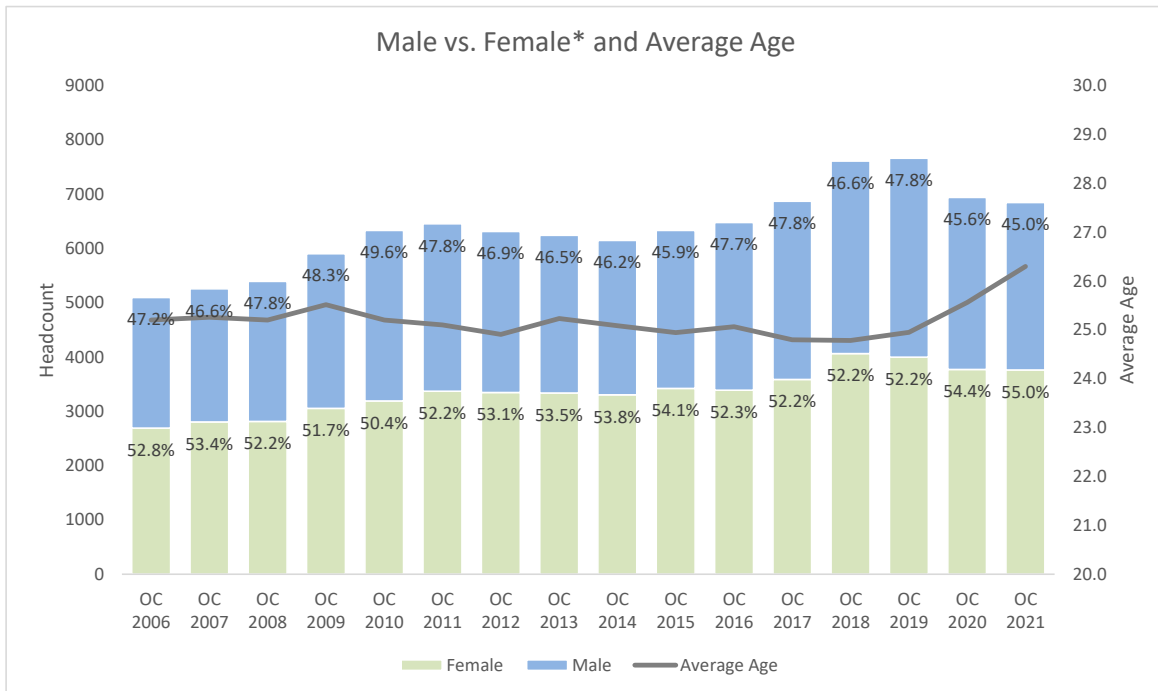
