Program Requirements

ENGLISH

Students that have completed a bachelor's degree taught in English do not need an English test. They can include a letter from their university confirming English was the medium of instruction for their program.

- GCSE O level OR GCSE A level English Language or Literature (a grade of C) **OR**
- IELTS Academic 6.0 in all bands **OR**
- Duolingo 105 **OR**
- TOEFL iBT 79

MATH

- GCSE O with a C or better **OR**
- GCSE A with a C or better **OR**
- College Algebra with a 60% or better **OR**
- Grade 11 Core General math and Pre Calculus with a 60%

OTHER SUBJECTS

- Additional subjects may be required depending on the specific programs.

Required Documents for Application

- ✓ Official results of the national high school leaving examination (Note: A high school transcript alone will not suffice)
- ✓ Passport data page
- ✓ For those who have any post-secondary education,
 - Graduation certificate
 - Transcript Graduation certificate
- ✓ For those applying for a post-baccalaureate program, we require an **WES** course-by-course evaluation



Tuition and Fees

APPLICATION FEE – CAD \$100 (non-refundable)

ADMISSION DEPOSIT – CAD 1 year's tuition (non-refundable)

TUITION COST – Varies by program. See estimated Costs CR code below.
