Program Requirements

ENGLISH

Students that have completed their education in English, do not need to submit an English proficiency test score if they have one of the grades shown below or have a 4- year degree completed in English.

- GCSE O level OR GCSE A level English Language or Literature (a grade of C) **OR**
- GCE AO level General Paper English Language or Literature (a grade of C) **OR**
- High School national exam English Literacy result 70% (National test names vary by country) **OR**
- IELTS Academic 6.0 in all bands **OR**
- Duolingo 105

MATH

- GCSE O with a C or better **OR**
- GCSE A with a C or better **OR**
- High School national exam Math result with a grade of 70%, C or 6 or higher

OTHER SUBJECTS

- Additional subjects may be required depending on the specific programs.

Required Documents for Application

- ✓ Official results of the national high school leaving examination (Note: A high school transcript alone will not suffice)
- ✓ Passport data page
- ✓ For those who have any post-secondary education,
 - Graduation certificate
 - Transcript Graduation certificate
- ✓ For those applying for a post-baccalaureate program, we require an **WES** course-by-course evaluation



Tuition and Fees

APPLICATION FEE – CAD \$100 (non-refundable)

ADMISSION DEPOSIT – CAD \$10,000 (non-refundable)

TUITION COST – Varies by program. See estimated Costs CR code below.

Applications open for January: First business day of February of the preceding year.
