


# Should I include a letter of explanation with my PGWP application? **YES!**

**Step 1: Review the Guide** Review the [OC How-to Apply Guide](#) for the required documents and submission steps.

**Step 2: Draft a Letter of Explanation.** Briefly outline who you are, what program you have graduated from, and explain how you met the requirements to be eligible for the post-graduation work permit (PGWP).

If you submitted your study permit application before November 1, 2024, you may use the template below (Adapt to your facts):
